1 Background

Since past seven years, VAAGDHARA has been organizing tribal sovereignty campaigns in VAAGAD region with different approaches ensuring participation of tribal communities. Initiative began inten villages with objectives to understand and mainstream development priorities and sovereignty issues of the communityin year 2014. Over a period of time, reaching out to community for dialogue, campaigns havebecome an important method of the organization. It helps usunderstand issues that demand planning with community institutions. Campaign took different forms where road march, night meetings (ratrichaupal), meeting with specific groups (women & children) were organised with village level community institutions. These discussions focused on various issues of rights and entitlements of the people. Issues encompassed understanding of their livelihood resources, traditional wisdoms and practices covering range of major themes of agriculture, education, children, women empowerment and much more. All through the last decade, series of such events both major and minor, from village level meetings to weeks long Yatra (march) to a big fat "Agriculture and Tribal SovereinityConlave" where thousands of farmers (both men and women) and community leaders participate actively are organised in this series. Participants prepare their demand charters to place before different government and nongovernment stakeholder for changes in policy.

Experiencing diverse learning through this journey, number of traditional practices, resources, legacy, cultural inheritance and ideological wisdom of community have been indentified along with vulnerable areas acting as impendiments. All this needed attention and desired action from the community. While keeping all this in mind, a march began on birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi Ji on 2nd Oct 2021. This march also known as "saving tribal inheritance and sovereignty campaign" (VIRASAT SWARAJ YATRA) has been designed and executed with concept of understand the contradictions in concurrent development approach and sovereignty (विकास एवंस्वराज). The modern development approach is contradictory to sovereignty and conservation of the resources, cultural and ideological inheritance resulting in increased vulnerability on various fronts.

2 Introduction to Virasat- Swaraj Yatra- 2021-22

The understanding limited of inheritance (virasat) and heritage outside tribal communitieshas been explored from different angles. The inseparable relationship between the conservation of inheritance and selfdependency (swaraj) in development actions has been recognized during its course. It may include forest, water resources, your soil, seeds, culture, thoughts and ideas, beliefs, a banyan tree in village and much more. Largely, it is both material and immaterial ways of life that has sustained tribal communities over

centuries only by their inherent acts of adopting those ways.But,when modern development approaches were perceived as only solution to issues affecting communities, it was found that these conversely give minimal attention to conservation of our inheritance, self-dependency/self-sufficiency within and among communities. Since, modern development practices havelittle effectiveness and suatainable impact, if "progess& growth" ignores protection of our collective inheritance while disregarding the idea of SWARAJ. The belief that conservation and protection of our inheritance (VIRASAT) and consequently attaining SWARAJ is near to impossible without putting significant efforts into it.

In continuation to previous community level campaigns, Virasat Swaraj Yatra 2020-21 has been planned and conducted with the objectives to sensitize communities and other stakeholders on the importance of protecting rich legacy/ inheritance and become self-dependent.

Coverage: The campaign (Yatra) began on October 2nd by commemorating birthday of Mahatma Gandhi at VAAGDHARA campus Kupda in Banswara district of Rajasthan. Members from other civil society organizations collaborated with VAAGDHARA to lead this nationwide campaign. Mr. Rajendra Singh Rana alias WatermanfromTarun Bharat Sangh and Asaha Ben also joined on this occasion. A route mapcovering 12 blocks of vaagad region pitching thousands of family members inmore than 1000 from 2nd of Oct 2021 to 21st of Oct 2021 was planned and implemented. In Vaagad, the campaign was culminated on 21st of Oct. 202, but sovereignty march moving ahead in other states with participation of othercivil society organizations and their respective communities engaged with them.Yatra began locally linked its implications innational and international domains to garner support for advocating issues of conservation of our heritage and securing sovereignty.

During the campaign, a team of community institutions and facilitators reached tovillage of blocks and communicated ideas of yatra and held discussions with people. The village level institutions, women groups, and children joined yatrain villages by conducting public meetings and distributing pamphlets. Progessing through each block, yatra held a large meeting at one central village of the block convenient for all campaigners. This meeting is centerstage of heritage and inheritance of that block. People brought locally found biodiversity and seeds in this meet.Exhibitions showcased by people showed remarkable evidence of inheritance, seed diversity and traditional wisdoms.

3 Foundational Areas of Dialogue in Virasat Swaraj Yatra

Virasat Swaraj Yatradrawedcertain circles around which discussions were held during entire campaign. These included areas which are direct relation to tribal communities and should be communicated everyone around the world. These areas include Jal Swaraj, Mitti Swaraj, Beej Swaraj, Van Swaraj, Food and Nutritional Sovereignity and above all Vaicharik Swaraj. All these areas are considered of great importance during this march to raise concluosness among people about their collective heritage that needs to be protected and conserved for future generation to cherish. Each topic is discussed below with fundamental questions that have been raised in discussion with people to raise an inner awareness among them.



3.1 Jal Swaraj

During the Virasat Swaraj Yatra, water was one of most important issue that was discussed. Various relevant questions asked to people. Are we conserving and maintaining our water resources in sustainable way? What is the status of our water sources? What is the water conservation system at the local level presently? What methods of water conservation have been adopted by farmers of village? What is the importance of water in life? Are policies and schemesfor water conservation and management are in synchronization with local needs of people?

3.2 Beej Swaraj

What is the importance of traditional seeds and landraces in our farming system? What practices help farmers to obtain healthy traditional seeds for agriculture? How many farmers are using improved traditional seeds? Do farmers in villages follow the practice of tranditional seed conservation and exchange among themselves? What are the traditional methods for treatment of seeds? How many of farmers are practicing the traditional methods of seed treatment? Can we improve traditional landraces by locally available wisdom with people for ensuring our livehood?

3.3 Van Swaraj

What importance do forests have in our life? Do you protect it or not? If protected, what methods are adopted by community locally? Do you obtain forest produce? How are you saving this forest produce locally? What are major forest conservation practices followed by our ancestors?What changes are noticed in measures adopted by communities at present compared to earlier times? What are special provisions and policies in tribal area under Forest Rights Act. Do current policies and legislations helpful in conservation of forests and incur benefits to the local communities?

3.4 Mitti Swaraj

What difference is observed in quality of soil over past 3 to 4 decades? Does soil in farms contains living organisms like earthworm that positively increases its productivity? Is it useful to make soil alive? How can the soil be made alive? What are the methods adopted? Have we maintained the soil conditions/ health as it was passed on to our generation. What measures are required to improve and regain our soil? If current use of fertilizers and chemicals are causing harm to soil health, what measures will you adopt to mitigate in this situation? Are people aware of methods for soil conservation? To what extent farmers are using organic fertilizers?

3.5 Food and Nutrition Swaraj

Have you heard of milltes like Bavta/Kang/Kuri/China/Kodo? How people in earlier days tend to use them? How are they cultivated? Does anyone cultivate them now? Do tribal cultures have anything to do with these crops? Does consumption of millets seemed health for us? Why they are not cultivated on a large scale presently? What is the reason? Are their seeds available? What do you all think about prevalence of diseases these days among in people? How many children are

malnourished in your village? What efforts are being made to reduce the prevalence of malnutrition? What is the difference between self-grown and market-bought food?

3.6 Vaicharik Swaraj (Thoughts and Ideological Sovereignty)

What do you mean by thoughts/ideological Swaraj? How much respect is given to each other's views in our community? Is there ever any ideological difference? If yes, what is the reason? What is importance of people's participation in village development? Do people in villages provide space to poorest amongst the poor to putforth their voice? Why is Gram Sabha needed? What do you mean by 'Gram Swaraj' and how can it be adopted?

During open discourses the major issues addressing the theme of the campaign many other allied issues are discussed in detail viz; what relation does a tribal family hold with animals? Which animals do we keep, is there any relation to the risks of our life with them? Does animal husbandry reduce the risk to the farmer? Does animal husbandry have anything to do with agriculture? Is there any scope for improvement in animal husbandry?

Discussion also oriented on role of community in the protection of children's rights. What efforts are being made by community for child friendly environment in villages? Are we talking beyond enrolment of children and asking for quality education? How will you make your village a child friendly and facilitate children enjoy their rights?

Do we have required schooling infrastructure and support system? What we can do for that? How many children go to study outside village? Do girls also go to study in other villages? At what age marriage happens in village? Does community understand the child labor? How many Anganwadis are there in village? Does children upto the age of 6 years associated with the Anganwadi?

4 Areas of discussion during Virasat Swaraj Yatra by Janjatiye Swaraj Sangathans

Over the entire course of yatra, several issues were discussed related to heritage and inheritance with people. Major learning from the discussion can be enlisted in the form of below areas. These are also instrumental to VAAGDHARA as we have been putting efforts from several years for promotion and protection of these practices.

- i. Recognition and mapping of local crop biodiversity and opportunities
- ii. Soil Health
- iii. Water use and conservation
- iv. Food and Nutritional issues
- v. Traditional Knowledge & Inheritance Revival/Conservation (Revival of haat, Halma, Notra)
- vi. Forest Management and Conservation

4.1 Mapping of local crop biodiversity and opportunities

Virasat Swaraj Yatra initiated discussion on conserving crop biodiversity. Usage of many landraces are found to be reduced in villages some time back. These are either not in farmingpractice or gone completely out of cultivation from past two decades. The local crop and vegetation diversity has an important role in supporting sustainable farming and environmental system. These form a self-sustained where farmers were system,

self-reliant.fortunately, few farming families and people in villages are still conserving local biodiversity. Thus, the issue of conservation of biodiversity through number of actions have been discussed and planned by the community institutions. Farmers are now adopting the seed conservation and exchange practices. The planning of community seed management system is completed by sangatahns and women groups. They are going all out in 1000 villages in phased manner in coming three years with a plan to establish Community Managed Seed System with the help of women groups in villages under the mentorship of sangathans. All important varieties are mapped and assessed along with degree of threat by extinction. The germ plasm of rare or unknown local seed races will be registered with the Government gene bank for research and recognition purpose. Local farmer varieties will be identified and brought into the legal recognition as farmers varities of seed.

Seed diversity exhibition remains one of the major attractions during Virasat Swaraj Yatra. The seeds, fruits and plant parts of the many rare types of millet, vegetables, fruits and medicinal plants were brought to the exhibition by the farmers. The seeds exchange was observed among farmers. Some rare types of vegetable and grains were not even known to young farmers participating in yatra.

4.2 Maintaing Soil Health for Future Generations

Swaraj Yatra has been useful in identifying issue of degrading soil in region. Throughout the campaign soil remaineda major topic of discussion. Land degradation due to changes in farming practices were discussed and understood by thousands of the farmers. Exhibitions of soils from different villages in events along with seeds and other articles percolated a message among about importance of soil.During yatra, soil was worshiped as mother and considered as a living entity giving life not only to us but to living being above its surface. It nurtures millions of lives under and above the surface that makes it alive. Unfortunately, use of excessive chemical fertilizers, poisonous substances, chemical wastes, dumping of industrial wastes and many other human activities like over grazing, deforestation, erosion by wind and water, frequent flooding and excessive irrigation, use of deep ground water, salinization etc. are immense negative effects on soil. The degradation in soil health is directly impacting lives of farmers by reducing the productivity.

Sangathans and farmers from VAAGAD region have planned to act upon the issue affirmatively. Community Institutions which involves sangathans, women group (Saksham Samooh), VDCRC members along with SWARAJ MITRA are actively organizing soil health awareness programmes in each hamlet.Sensitization of communityfor protecting and improving soil health is take people in mission mode. Community also understood the importance of Ecologically Harmonised Village Development Plans in achieving desired results in conserving soil health. Sangathan leaders through Janjatiye Vikas Manch also resolved policy advocacy initiatives for the purpose. They are approaching to authorities in government to have soil health card and testing facilities at Panchayat level besides demanding for more allocation of resources and investments villages and panchayats for soil conservation interventions.

4.3 Water use and conservation (Action for Jal Swaraj)

Virasat Swaraj Yatra has identified issues regardingavailability and access of water by the farming community in entirevaagad region. In this region, many families are dependent only through rainfed agriculture and consequently able to reap only single major crop in the entire year. It makes them vulnerable and livelihood security is compromised leading to propensity of migration. In some parts of this region, network of irrigation canals by Mahi dam supplies water but villages towards tail end of canals are deprived of water supply for irrigation. Many a times, farmers encounter loss of their crops due insufficient or no supply of water during *rabi* season. Additionally, these canals also need repair and maintenance due to some permanent damages. Sangathans have raised demand in this regard to minister of water resources for extension and repair of canals. They have been able advocate their issue and convinced the authorities for repair and extension of the irrigation canals. The minister committed investment plan of rupees 2000 crores for repair of exiting canals by

construction of nearly 50 kilometers network of new canals and distributaries covering most of the villages of VAGAD region. At micro level where the canal network may not reach, minister also promised to construct small water bodies mean for irrigation at village level. 100 small anicuts and checkdams are proposed on demand of sangathans and JanjatiyeVikas Manch. In gramsabhas, VDCRC are also submitted EHVDP plans proposing individual land-based farm ponds and micro-irrigation systems under convergence plans from MGNREGA, department of horticulture and Agriculture.

4.4 Food and nutritional security of tribal families

Food and Nutrition related issues were discussed during Virasat Swaraj Yatra. The region though faces lack of food security in general but itexacerbated during COVID-19 pandemic. Although, community has shown greater resilience through indigenous practices like saving seeds and drying vegetables for their consumption. Some even extended support to neighbors as well. The long-term action for accessing employment in MGNREGA was initiated by Sangathan and VAAGDHARA to ensure food security among families. Farmers have also adopted mixed cropping to have most of the crops cultivated at local level.

Nutritional aspectsare highly related to children and women. Anemia and malnutrition remain one of the prominent issues in community. The issue was discussed and taken up by Sangathan on large scale. Being very poor in nutritional standards, whole VAAGAD region is found to have thousands of children and women living in malnourishment. A strategic term plan was prepared by Sangathan and VAAGDHARA at micro level to work for the eradication of nutritional deficiency/ malnutrition among children and women.

A pilot programme was prepared by Sangathan and VAAGDHARA with District Administration, Department of Health, and ICDS a launched through supplementary nutritional campaign in five blocks and 750 villages covering all undernourished children after taking baseline through anthropometric measurements. A month-long nutrition campaign resulted in positive outcomes with 70% of children coming out of malnourished category. Understanding the potential of the intervention, district administration has decided to scale up this campaign on large scale with the help of Sangathan and VAAGDHARA.

As part of long-term strategic action, farmers from all 1000 villages of Sangathanestablished nutrition garden for cultivating vegetables. For lean periods, farmers have also started preserving dry vegetables and pulses to fulfil household needs.

4.5 Conservation of Traditional Knowledge, Culture, Heritage and Inheritance (Revival of haat bazaar, Halma, Notra)

Public meetings during Virasat Swaraj Yatra proved to begreat platform for discussing and sharing traditional knowledge and practices followed by peoplein villages. Participants shared many such practices followed by community to help each other and reduce drudgery. Halma (voluntary labour) was organized by people for cleaning village drainage system, cleaning of common ponds and wells. Participants also shared about pooling financial resources to help on certain occasions through organizing *Notra*. These common efforts were helping community to maintain a bond of trust and love with each other. They never required any external labor or help for doing many such works. Community also has institutionalized a practice haat bazaar to facilitate the exchange of goods locally on fixed one day of week. All local commodities were exchanges among people through this. During this campaign, community institutions have come forward to revive most of such practices like Halma, Notra, haat bazaar etc.

4.6 Community Forest Management and conservation

Forest based resources constitutes one of the major livelihood of the community in this region. The tribal community is known to live in harmony with forests and wildlife. They are often considered conservers of forest and nature. However, with changing pattern of livelihood and unfavorable government policies most forests are degrading. During yatra, it was shared by many community members that, certain good examples of community managed forests under Joint Forest Management programmes still exist among us. With an arrangement of the benefit sharing and use of the non-timber forest produce (NTFPs) from scheduled forest area, community have access to harvest and sell bamboo, tendu leaves, grasses, fuel wood, gum, honey medicinal plants etc. Under the Rajasthan Forest Right Acts 2015 (FRA) in schedules areas, the Village Joint Forest Management Committees are formed but not functional and active in most of the villages. Sangathan were sensitized to revive such committees and take over the management of the forest land demarcated for joint management.

5 Celebrating "Soil as Mother" (World Soil Day Celebration)

Under series of events pertaining to Agriculture and Tribal Sovereignty Campaign 2021-22, one day dialogue with community was organized on 2nd of Dec. 2021 to understand the importance of soil health before World Soil Day. The dialogue was organized with objective to orient Swaraj Mitras (sovereignty torch bearers) from around 1000 villages to organize a grand event of world soil day on 5th of December. The event was graced by Mr. Mahendrajeet Singh Malvia, Minster of Water Resources and Irrigation, Government of Rajasthan. Discussion began with Prayer of Mother Earth and Cow, both the symbols of rural livelihoods resources. On this occasion, VAAGDHARA managed to avail 70 Sirohi Breed Goats to women farmer belonging to vulnerable families of the

Vaagad region. The occasion was felicitated by the Cabinet Minister Mr. M.S. Malvia and handed over the goats to the women farmer. The promotion of improved small ruminants among the community is one of the major strategies to execute major components of Sustainable Integrated Farming System.

As planned with Swaraj Mitras, Thousands of hands rose together to save the soil... Pledge to improve the health of the soil

World Soil Day has been organized every year on 5th December by the UN's Agriculture and Food Organization in collaboration with member countries around the world. Climate change is causing many adverse effects on soil and water. Due to abundant use of chemical fertilizers and pesticides, soil is becoming hard and barren. The concern over deteriorating health of soil is increasing around the world.

People all over the world organized programs at different levels to raise consciousness about improving soil health. VAAGDHARAalso joined hands with Tribal Swaraj Organizations and Tribal Development Forumfor celebrating"World Soil Day" in 1000 villages of the region. It was organized in five districts of the tribal tri-junction i.e., Banswara, Dungarpur, Pratapgarh and Jhabua, Ratlam and Dahod districts of Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat. Nearly one lakh community members participated during celebration. During the celebration, gatherings wereconducted in villages where discussions were held onpractices needed improving soil health.

In India and especially tribals, people have asacred relationship with soil. Most importantly, communities are dependent on soil for their livelihood. In such a situation, it becomes even more imperative to understand its importance and motivate actions for preservation of soil.During this year, World Soil Day celebration wasaimed to encourage and motivate policy makers, scientists and other stakeholders to work in a directioncontributes to improve soil health. As healthy soilensures food security, restores changing environment and have positive impact on lives of farming communities, deteriorating soil health has become a matter of great concern which has severe consequences. Discussions held on true farming interventions of VAAGDHARA which focuses on regaining soil health while adapting resilient agricultural practices.

The celebration in villages involved community institutions such as Village Development and Child Rights Committee, Saksham Samooh, Sangathanin every village along with community members. The grouptoured entire village with drums, informing more and more people about event and brought soil and water from their fields to the venue for celebration. During the celebration, panchayat representatives, ward panch and other influential members of the community also took part in it. During discussions, special focus was given to save our heritage like agricultural implements, small grains, traditional water resources-river, pond, step-well, well, soil, seeds, culture, beliefs, etc. and pass on safely to future generations. These implements and tools also help soil health in several ways.

Agricultural experts of VAAGDHARA asked to compare soil three decades ago to its hardened state presently. The soil has come to form due to use chemical fertilizers, medicines/ pesticides in abundance. The decrease in humus content of soil is major concern nowadays which needs to be cured with immediate efforts was conveyed to participants. Earlier, humus content in soil has maintained its balance but recent agricultural practices have caused more damage to this balance in soil. Community members resolved to maintain this balance by taking permanent effective measures.

Vaagdhara secretary Jayesh Joshi told that we have to follow our ancestors to keep the soil fertile and productive. Therefore, it is necessary to adopt traditional farming methodswhich includeuse indigenous practices like manure, vermin compost to bring back to its natural form. Continuous efforts of community are required to retain our collective heritage with us as well to future generations. In this event, while sharing the local knowledge and methods for soil conservation, the officials of Tribal Development organization (Sangathan) requested all the participants to becomecognizant of land development work done by their panchayats and government to stop soil erosion of their agricultural fields. Therefore, it becomes important for people in the village to become conscious about village development plans and its proper implementation. It becomes responsibility of people to suggest large number of works under land and water conservation, anicut, check dam construction etc. in the village development plans, besides ensuring community participation at all levels. At the end of the event, people took resolve to put concerted collective effort towards this goal.

6 Potential Community Leaders and Areas of Interest for Action

While, Virasat Swaraj Yatra was running its course, numerous participants (both women and men), especially youths were identified and listed with the help of community institutions. These individuals were active in their socio-cultural domain and helped voluntarily in various concerns of their villages. These heroes are rarely recognized for their efforts. These identified volunteers are important persons for future initiative and follow-ups after culmination of Virasat Swaraj Yatra. They will inspire other community member locally to keep alive this movement to largerpublic base. Based onrespective interests and experience of volunteers, names were suggested by community institutions. They were also categorized to specificareas where responsibilitytaken by them.

Along with this, there were women farmers found to practice seed conservation. Women were promoting natural farming practice and adopting organic fertilizers and pest management. Poultry and livestock management is also taken up them. Volunteers are reaching to veterinary department and organizing animal health camp for improved cattle management. They are also making community aware about the indigenous livestock improvement by introducing the improved breed

of local races of goats and chicks. They actively participate in PLA Chaupal and act as catalytic agent to mobilize people to participate in GramSabhas to get their issue heard. Their participation in gramsabhas ensures submission of people centric plans. Based on the thematic areas they are interested in community sovereignty are namedSwaraj Mitra) say Food and Nutrition Swaraji , Jal Swaraji, Mitti Swaraji, Beej Swaraji, VaicharikkSwaraji, Van Swaraji. These lead champion farmers are seen as the key change agents who would be not just influencing but also create peer learning environments.

Annexure 1: Community Institutions

Village Development and Child Rights Committee (VDCRC)

VDCRC is gender balanced committee of 25 members which works towards village development and realization of child-friendly environment in the village. Members of VDCRC come from different hamlets in the village and meet regularly to discuss issues related to development at village level. VDCRC with help of facilitation by Swaraj Mitra regularly organize "Gram Chopal" in village where different stakeholder responsible for village development initiatives and village members come to discuss different issues and find solutions. Session of "Gram Chopal" is in form of Participatory Learning and Action which helps Swaraj Mitra in facilitation for sustainable solutions to local problems.

Saksham Samooh (SS)

Saksham Samoohs are women groups in 1000 intervention village of VAAGDHARA also known as Smart Women Farmer's Group. In each village, there exists a Saksham Samooh which comprises of 20 women from different directions/hamlets in village to collectively work on Sustainable Integrated Farming System (SIFS). With the help of facilitation by Swaraj Mitra Saksham Samooh organizes Participatory Learning and Action session regularly to learn about SIFS. Thereafter, Women members in Saksham Samooh extend their learning to other five women in their hamlet for adoption. Meanwhile they discuss several concerns in agriculture.

Janjatiye Swaraj Sangathan (JSS)

Janjatiye Swaraj Sangathan is people's organization facilitated by VAAGDHARA which is formed for geographically proximate 35-40 villages. Members of VDCRC and Saksham Samooh are part of it. A gender balanced core group of 18-20 leaders is chosen from VDCRC and Saksham Samooh of all 35-40 villages by themselves with representation from all Gram Panchayats encompassing the sangathans work area. Sangathan's core group of leaders meet regularly to discuss common issues which come out on "Gram Chopals". These issues are advocated at panchayat, block and district level of administration for their solutions. Sangathans raise people's voice reaching to different authorities concerned. Currently, there are 27 JSS facilitated by VAAGDHARA through 3 Janjatiye Swaraj Sangathan Sahyog Ikais (Facilitation Units) i.e. MAHI, MANGARH and HIRAN.
